

## **How to Obtain Your**

## **Certified Food Protection Manager certificate**

Take an ANSI (American National Standards Institute) approved Certified Food Protection Managers (CFPM) course. The CFPM certificate is required to open a cottage food operation. Five options to obtain this certificate are available locally:

- Frontier Community College (<u>www.iecc.edu/fcc</u>) in Fairfield offers a regularly scheduled day-long Sanitation & Safety Class. The CFPM exam is taken at the end of the class. Call 618-842-3711 to register.
