



How to Obtain Your Certified Food Protection Manager certificate

Food establishments rated Medium & High Risk must have at least one employee with their Certified Food Protection Manager certification (CFPM) present during **ALL** operating hours and **Cottage Food businesses** must have one CFPM.

Here are options to obtain this certificate:

- **ServSafe** (www.servsafe.com/ServSafe-Manager) offers an online CFPM course & online exam proctoring. ServSafe is the national leader in training and certification.
